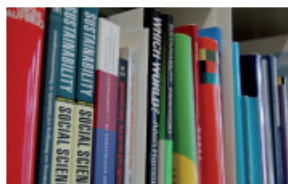
## Documentation & Library

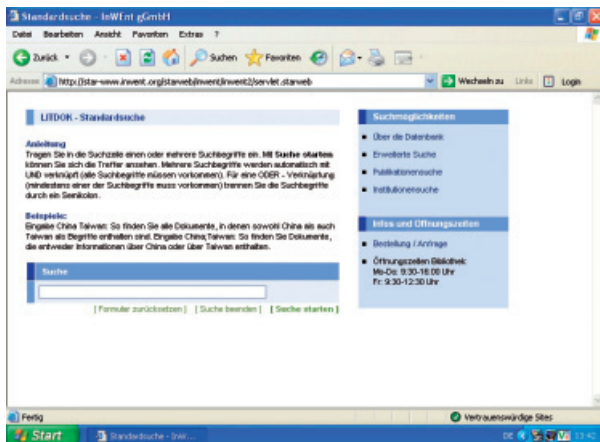

- The publication database **PUBDOK** collects about 300 publications of InWEnt.
