Richard Howitt MEP has served as the European Parliament Rapporteur on Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) in three successive Parliaments. He proposed and serves as parliamentary representative on the European Multi-Stakeholder Forum on CSR since 2002. Richard represents the European region in several global CSR initiatives, serving as a member of the Governmental Advisory Group of the Global Reporting Initiative and as a Friend of the OECD Guidelines on Multinational Enterprise. He was asked by Professor John Ruggie to chair the governmental consultation on his work as the UN Secretary General's Special Representative on Business and Human Rights.
